IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2022• 2023, ACADEMIC AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS WERE AWARDED TO 264 INDIVIDUALS PRIMARILY IN HENDERSON COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA. PRIOR PERIOD ADJUSTMENTS: DURING THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2023, IT WAS DISCOVERED THAT AN AGENCY FUND HAD BEEN IMPROPERLY CLASSIFIED AS AN ENDOWMENT FUND DURING THE YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 2021. AS A RESULT, FUNDS HELD AS ORGANIZATIONAL ENDOWMENTS HAVE BEEN INCREASED BY \$618,925 AND NET ASSETS WITH DONOR RESTRICTIONS HAS BEEN DECREASED BY \$618,925 IN THE ACCOMPANYING JUNE 30, 2022, STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL POSITION.

ADDITIONALLY, THE JUNE 30, 2022, STATEMENT OF ACTIVITIES INCLUDES A DECREASE IN NET CONTRIBUTIONS OF \$200,000, DECREASE IN INVESTMENT INCOME OF \$13,833, DECREASE IN NET LOSSES ON INVESTMENTS OF \$94,908, AND DECREASE IN NET ASSETS AT THE BEGINNING OF THE YEAR OF \$500,000.
